



2021 Christmas At The Farm Guidelines

By submitting an application, all vendors and food trucks are agreeing to the outlined rules and regulations below, as well as to comply by all updates made to these conditions by Greenville Christmas Trees.

1. Fees are \$20/day for table vendors and \$25/day for food trucks. **Vendor payment is due 30 days before opening** (October 27, 2021). Failure to pay by this date will result in a forfeited spot. If the vendor cancels over 30 days before opening, a full refund will be issued. Cancellations made within 30 days will not be refunded, unless special exception is made by Greenville Christmas Trees for cases of family emergency, illness, etc. that will be determined on a case by case basis.
2. **Vendors are solely responsible to obtain insurance coverage** for all property brought to the Christmas At The Farm event. Greenville Christmas Trees and Arran Farm are void of any responsibility for any damage to or theft of property belonging to vendors, regardless of the cause. Any damages caused by the vendor or their property to Arran Farms, to Greenville Christmas Trees property, or to any persons on the property is the responsibility of the vendor to pay for based on a fair value assessed by Greenville Christmas Trees.
3. Vendor agrees to **set up between 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM** on Friday November 26, 2021. Vendors will also have the optional opportunity to arrive up to 30 minutes early on November 27th and 28th if they would like more time to set up on a daily basis. Times are subject to change.
4. Vendor agrees to **arrive on time and stay for the duration** of the event (Friday 11-9, Saturday 11-9, Sunday 12-6).
5. Vendor agrees to **tear down between 6:00 PM - 7:00 PM** on Sunday, November 28, 2021. Times are subject to change.
6. Vendors are responsible for cleaning their space and removal of trash. The space should be left as it was originally found.
7. **No nails, tacks, or any hanging devices are to be used on any barn walls or doors.** This venue is used weekly and the wood must be preserved.
8. Vendors are responsible to **provide their own table and chair(s)** for display of their products. Unfortunately we do not have extra.
9. Greenville Christmas Trees reserves the right to refuse any application for any reason. There is limited space and applications are competitive.
10. Vendor agrees to park their vehicle in the location designated by Greenville Christmas Trees during the time of the event, as will be instructed when the vendor arrives.
11. Space and location for vendors within the barn and for food trucks outside the barn are determined solely at the discretion of Greenville Christmas Trees. Vendor agrees to keep their set up in their originally outlined space, and will not share or sublet their space.
12. Vendors agree to comply with all local and federal law, beyond what is outlined in this agreement.
13. In the event of rain or snow, Christmas At The Farm plans to continue regardless. No refunds will be issued even in the event of inclement weather.
